The Fund has a specific commitment to supporting acts of conscience and nonviolent direct action for peace and social justice. We also have a commitment to working to challenge racism, sexism, and homophobia and to an affirmative action vision for overcoming the effects of hatred and injustice.

Grants up to \$1,000 are available for specific actions, not for general support of organizations, and with a limit of one per year per group.

To apply for a grant, submit a letter of request, including:

- 1) name of sponsoring organization of the planned demonstration or action (and other supporting organizations), plus sponsor's address, phone, contact person, and amount of request;
- 2) plan of action;
- 3) statement of commitment to nonviolence, brief history of the sponsoring organization, and how the commitment to nonviolence will be demonstrated in the plan of action -- that is, will there be a stated nonviolence discipline? If so, please include it.
